Material Guide

Display Board is a 100% recyclable material that is often used in POS displays for mounting graphics on to. The material is a thick paper-based product that has some rigidity and strength to it. We have used it for header cards on temporary units.

How it's made...

Display Board is made from recycled material, the waste material is mashed into a pulp and then compressed to form Display Board. This gives the material a raw texture that could be described as similar to MDF or Valchromat.



PROS

- Display Board is made from recycled materials and can be recycled.
- It is a fairly rigid board that can be used to mount graphics too.
- It is a cheap product - for short term solutions Display Board is great.
- The raw look of the material appeals to displays in the arts & crafts sector.
- It comes in a range of thicknesses.



CONS

- It is not suitable for long term uses unless protected within the unit design.

If you need a large graphic with rigidity then Display Board is what you need to mount your graphic to. Within reason the material will stand up right with minimal support, it will also not bend and fold like a paper or card graphic might.
